“Beep Baseball” helps blind and visually impaired people play baseball. McIntire became a volunteer when an eye infection caused her 20-year-old son to lose his eyesight for one year. She has held many roles since then and has been scorekeeper for its World Series for the past five years.

In Beep baseball, the ball beeps, thanks to a rechargeable battery and built-in speaker. Balls cost \$35 each and teams can go through three or more balls per game, or about 80 per season.

“The Indy Thunder team uses my matching gift to purchase these balls, as the cost is over \$2,000 per season,” McIntire says. “This game is a great source of fun and a confidence builder for the team, and we truly appreciate the American Water Charitable Foundation’s generous matching gift.”
